Camp Mennoscah Covenant

I, _____, am entering into an agreement with Camp Mennoscah with a desire and expectation for a great summer of growth and fulfillment in God's creation and faith community. I understand that it will be hard work, requiring the dedication and commitment of a disciple. I will maintain a positive, affirmative attitude and will agree to abide by the policies and expectations of Camp Mennoscah and the Retreat Commission and Camp Director(s).

I commit to putting the needs of the campers, counselors, and other staff above my own.

I am aware that living and working together with other staff for an extended time can cause both positive and negative relationships. Positive relationships are good and healthy at camp, though public displays of affection are not appropriate at camp. Negative relationships shall remain between the parties involved and/or their supervisors. Campers and counselors should not be aware of any negative relationships between staff.

I will be sensitive to the needs of campers, spoken or unspoken, especially those of shy and withdrawn individuals.

As a role model, I will discourage the expression of ridicule among campers and counselors. I will not tolerate bullying or harassment in any form. I will stress the abilities and positive aspects of each person.

I will avoid comments or physical contact that can be interpreted as sexual advancement or harassment.

I will avoid any form of communication (letters, online/social networks, phone, texting) with campers that could be interpreted as flirtatious or have sexual meaning, regardless of how subtle. I will not instigate communication with a camper after the camp week has ended and will allow them to contact me first.

I will avoid abusive forms of contact and verbal behavior.

I will refrain from the use of profanity and off-color remarks and stories.

I am aware that many campers lack maturity to distinguish fantasy from reality, so therefore will not tell ghost stories to the younger children and choose carefully what I tell the older children.

I will not use alcohol, tobacco and illicit drugs on camp premises.

As a role model and friend, I am aware that I have a profound effect on the campers and will conduct myself in a manner worthy of being a summer staffer and a faithful member of God's community.

I will expect to have fun.

I have read the expectations described on this form and have been given opportunity to ask questions on items I did not understand. I hereby give Camp Mennoscah permission to obtain and maintain in my personnel file my complete criminal record obtained from law enforcement agencies. I certify that the above information, which I have given, is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and that misrepresentation and failure to abide by camp policies may be grounds for my dismissal. I hereby agree to abide by the policies of Camp Mennoscah.
